ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT POLICY AND STRATEGY COMMITTEE

TYPE OF COMMITTEE: Advisory

PURPOSE: The Economic Development Policy and Strategy Committee serves in a general advisory capacity to the Board and provides technical input on all matters relating to economic development. Specific responsibilities include:

- 1. Reviewing and establishing priorities for all ARC and EDA projects and to assist in the assembly of appropriate project packages.
- 2. Assisting in the review and establishment of priorities on other economic development project applications which involve this Agency.
- 3. Formulating appropriate work program activities for all economic development programs where this Agency receives administrative grants.
- 4. Aiding in the review of major economic proposals submitted to this Agency under the Intergovernmental Review process.
- 5. Provides input into and review of the Region's Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) and other such economic development policy documents developed by this Agency or submitted to this Agency for review. Develops, revises and monitors the CEDS on an ongoing basis. The Strategy Committee represents the main economic interests of the region and must include representation of the private sector as a majority of its membership. Is designated by the Board and is responsible for developing, revising, or replacing the CEDS. Additional representation will include public officials, community leaders, and representatives of workforce development boards, minority and labor groups, and private individuals.
- 6. Providing an exchange of information to ensure that the Board is acquainted with related economic activity programs, activities, and projects within the region.
