This is a unique job opportunity to work at a Regional Planning Board and provide technical assistance and training to governments and organizations within a three-county region. The full-time position is a civil service position, with a civil service exam to be given at a later date. The position will require regular attendance at night meetings.

STC seeks a dynamic individual who not only has the skills to complete planning-related projects, but can also manage and maintain GIS databases and services as needed. Independent judgment is encouraged for carrying out the details of the work. Applicant must possess excellent oral and written communication skills as well those outlined herein.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Write comprehensive plans
- Revise zoning laws
- Professional review of development projects
- Conduct trainings for municipal officials and boards
- Participate in meetings, seminars, conferences, and day-to-day meetings with local governmental units and agency representatives on the local, state, and federal levels
- Prepare reports required in conjunction with grants received
- Conduct studies for local governments and/or for inclusion in regional plans and reports
- Assist in grantwriting and grants management
- Assist in collection and analysis of data
- Make presentations to committees, boards, and local legislatures
- Maintain enterprise-related GIS databases and servers for broad use in the GIS and web mapping areas
- Develop automation protocols for loading spatial data using data modeling and attribute mapping and manages the defined workflow routines
- Work with regional GIS counterparts to populate spatial and enterprise databases, provide performance tuning, and assist with technical assistance related to ArcGIS desktop, data layers, and ArcGIS Online
- Knowledge of ArcGIS with geodatabase development, editing, analysis, and QA/QC
- Geodatabase development and analysis using GIS
- Microsoft Office
- SDE/Geodatabase administration

- Ability to multi-task, detail-oriented, and have strong organizational skills
- Data analysis, problem solving, and troubleshooting skills
- Strong teamwork and communication skills
- Administer ArcGIS Online Organizational Account
- Create ArcGIS Online maps, applications, and dashboards related to municipal and regional projects
- Willingness to learn and move to ArcGIS Pro when necessary

- (b) Master’s degree in Geography, Government, Economics, Political Science, Sociology, Public Administration, Statistics, or a closely-related field and one year of experience in municipal community or regional planning or related work; or
- (c) Bachelor’s Degree in Planning, Environmental Studies, Architecture, Engineering, Landscape Architecture, or a closely-related field and one year of experience in municipal, community or regional planning or related work.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a valid New York State driver’s license appropriate to the vehicles operated or otherwise demonstrate the ability to meet the transportation needs of the job.
