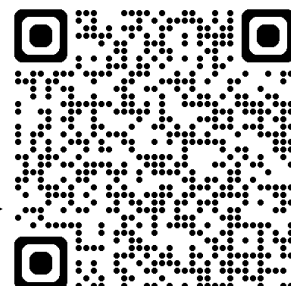
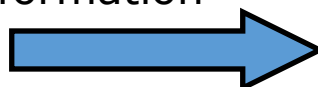

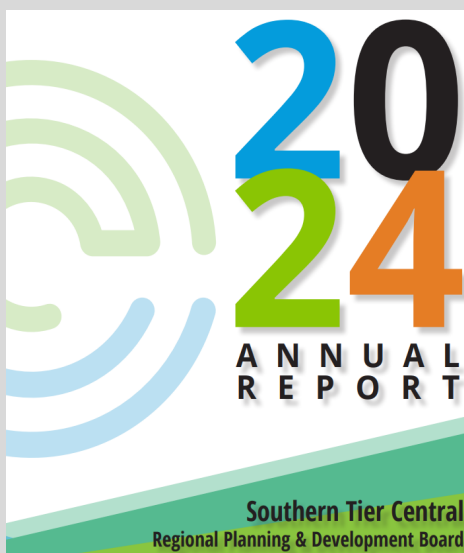


Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) for 2025-2030 is approved!

The theme of the CEDS for the next 5 years is collaboration and leveraging resources. STC's Staff completed work on the 2025-2030 CEDS re-write, with significant consideration to feedback from STC's Board, Committees, community partners, and the public. With this CEDS, STC is enabled to assist with regional development projects through leveraging connections and sharing information between existing entities. STC will assist with project development for projects with significant expected impacts in the realms of private industry, place-based investment, and human development.

## STC's Recent Achievements

As we reflect on the past year, the Southern Tier Central Regional Planning & Development Board (STC) remains committed to fostering economic growth, environmental sustainability, and community development across our region. This report highlights our achievements and challenges in 2024, while setting the stage for strategic goals for the coming year. At the end of 2024, STC secured \$8,846,677 in grant funding to support municipal, county, and regional projects. STC managed a balanced budget of \$1.4M, supporting a total of 10 employees, and increased partnerships with both public and private entities all in the effort to support our regional mission and set the course of prosperity, resilience and growth for years to come.
